- Q3. Discuss four different methods of controlling viral haemorrhagic fever in a population (25 marks).
- Q4. a) Discuss the factors that have led to the increase in non-communicable diseases in Kenya (10 marks).
- b) Describe possible strategies that would help in mitigating this trend in Kenya (15 marks).
